Retford Half Marathon and Fun Run – Terms & Conditions of Entry v1.0

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

In applying to enter the Retford Half Marathon or the Family Fun Run entrants agree / confirm that:

They will abide by U.K.A. rules (where appropriate), race rules and marshal instructions / directions.

Are taking part in the event at their own risk and are medically fit to take part in the event and to run a half marathon within 3 hours / run an approx. 1 mile fun run - as applicable.

Agree that the organisers will in no way be held responsible for any injury, loss or illness to their person during or as a result of the event.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse or cancel applications, to alter the date of the event, the course route or distance.

In the event that the race has to be shortened or cancelled by the organisers due to circumstances outside of their control entry fees will not be refunded.

Half marathon entrants will be 17 years or older on race day.

Fun Run entrants will be 7 years or older on race day.

Fun run entrants under 10 years of age will be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Parent or Guardian of any entrant under 18 years of age who is entering the event – Give consent that the individual entering the event can participate in the Retford Half Marathon/Fun run.

Medical treatment necessary may be given without reference to the participant (or parent / guardian for entrants under 18 years of age) and neither participants (nor parents / guardians for entrants under 18 years of age) will hold responsible the organisers of the event for any illness or injury resulting from the event.

Entrants understand that the use of iPods or MP3s/personal stereos (or similar) is not permitted at this event due to UKA rules and safety reasons (due to parts of the course being run on roads open to traffic, and runners needing to be aware of marshal instructions and emergency vehicles).

Entries to the Retford Half Marathon and Family Fun Run are personal to the applicant. Entrants promise not to re-sell, pass or transfer their entry to another person, or allow another person to wear their race number, even if they cannot participate due to injury or illness

Due to early costs the event organisers have to incur to stage the event, refunds cannot be given, and we are unable to offer deferrals, however we can permit the transfer of places up-to 10th February if the race is not already full. To transfer your place please contact us at retfordhalf@gmail.com with the full name, email address, mobile number, postal address, t-shirt size, gender, running club and UKA number (if applicable) of the runner you wish to transfer your place to before 10th February.

Entrants agree to receive emails, mailings, marketing and/or mobile phone text messages from the race organisers, the race photographers, sponsors and charities in relation to their application & participation in Retford Half Marathons or Family Fun Run (whilst retaining the right to opt out of further unrelated mailings and messages).

Entrants consent to still & motion images of their participation in the event being used for marketing and publicity purposes.

Entrants agree to their personal and medical details being released by the medical team to the event organisers to inform their next of kin and statutory authorities in the event of a medical emergency

Entrants to the Half Marathon and Fun Run will not participate in the event without first completing the next of kin and medical details form on the back of their race numbers.
